




FIG.3-TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS




INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD VOLTAGE,(V)

FIG.4-TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS




FIG.6-TEST CIRCUIT DIAGRAM AND REVERSE RECOVERY TIME CHARACTERISTIC
