

RATINGS AND CHARACTERISTIC CURVES SF11R THRU SF18R




FIG.3—TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS
FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS




FIG.5-TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE




FIG.2-MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT






FIG.4-TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS
